

**KGD Crowd Control at School Sponsored Activities (See EBC) KGD**

1 Disorder and disruption of school activities will not be tolerated. Persons  
2 attempting to endanger the safety of themselves or others, to damage school  
3 property, or to interfere with school activities or the educational process shall  
4 be held accountable.

5 The school administration and staff are responsible for handling any  
6 problem caused by adults or students. The final decision for determining if  
7 assistance is needed at a disturbance, disorder or demonstration is the  
8 responsibility of the school principal. In the absence of the principal, the  
9 determination shall be made by an assistant principal or the person designated  
10 to be in charge of the building or activity. The superintendent shall be notified  
11 of any serious problem at the school.

12 **Criminal Possession of a Firearm** (See JCDBB)

13 It is illegal for any person, other than a law enforcement officer, to  
14 possess a weapon in or on any school property, school grounds, or any district  
15 building or structure used for student instruction or attendance or  
16 extracurricular activities of pupils, or at any regularly scheduled school  
17 sponsored activity or event. This prohibition includes concealed weapons even  
18 if the person has a legal permit. **Appropriate signs shall be posted as directed**  
19 **by the Board.**
