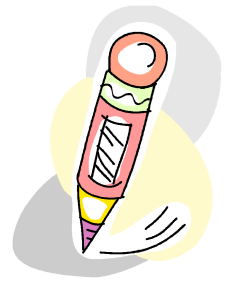




Elementary School Supply List 2009-2010

and to replace as necessary throughout the school year.

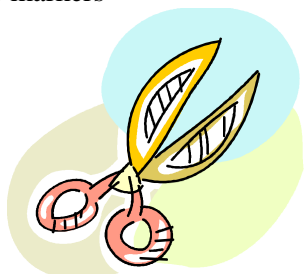
- Fees for textbook rental and other instructional costs will be collected at the beginning of the school year.

- Trapper-keeper notebooks are not needed.
- Mark all supplies with permanent ink (with the exception of facial tissue boxes).

Kindergarten

- 2 pkgs washable Crayola CLASSIC color markers (8 per pkg)
- 1 box Prang (preferred) or Crayola (acceptable) watercolor paints
- 1 pkg baby wipes
- 1 or 2 boxes 200-count facial tissues
- 1 STANDARD size backpack
- 1 4-oz bottles Borden's or Elmer's white glue
- 1 glue stick
- 1 box #8 THIN Crayola classic color crayons
- 1 box #16 THIN Crayola classic color crayons
- 1 set Play Dough containers (standard size)
- 1 box Ziploc bags
- 1 pair small scissors (Fiskar)
- 2 thin-point dry erase markers

First Grade

- 2 boxes 12 #2 pencils
- 2 boxes 200-count facial tissues
- 1 4-oz Borden's or Elmer's white glue
- 3-4 glue sticks
- 1 plastic school box (no larger 9x6x2) for storing materials
- 4 plain colored pocket folders
- 2 rubber erasers (not art gum)
- 1 STANDARD backpack (no wheels)
- 1 composition book (not spiral)
- 1 box Ziploc bags - quart or gallon size
- 1 pair small scissors (Fiskar)
- 2 thin-point dry erase markers

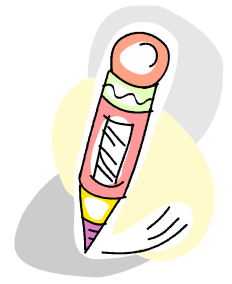
