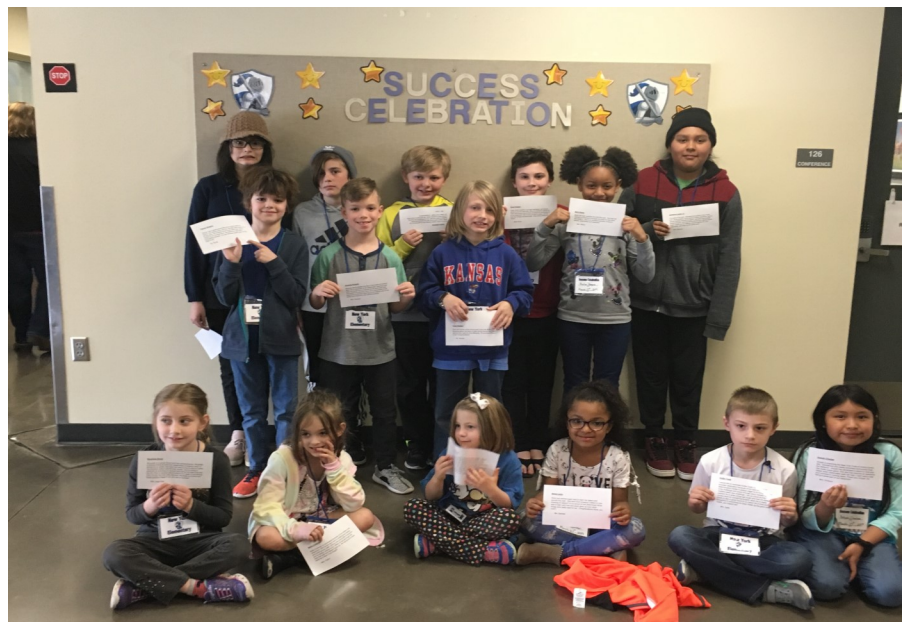
## 🎵 Music Programs 🎵
