Re: Purchase of iPad Cases for Middle School Refresh

Date: May 18, 2017

Background:

All four USD 497 middle schools operate in a 1:1 iPad environment. Each student has an iPad that is equipped with a rugged protective case and they are allowed to personalize their cases.

Rationale:

As the Technology Services Department prepares for the second year of the 1:1 environment at the middle schools, the iPads which were used by the eighth-grade students will be defaulted and made ready for incoming sixth graders. Since the students were allowed to personalize their cases, it is important to replace them over the summer. A bid has been received from Kansas City Audio Visual (KCAV) in the amount of \$58,500 under State Contract #35416.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval for the purchase of replacement iPad cases from KCAV in the amount of \$58,500 to be paid from Capital Outlay - Technology Funds (0900500000-56500).
