Re: Track Resurface – Free State

Date: April 7, 2016

Background:

At its February 22, 2016 meeting, the Board of Education was presented with and approved the Capital Improvement Project list. Included in this plan was the resurfacing of the 400 meter running track at Free State High School. The current track is toward the end of the life expectancy and is in need of repair. The description of work is listed below.

Bids and Specifications:

- Cut and patch (4 areas) 4'x5' areas on the long jump runways
- Cut and patch (2 areas) on the edge of the Javelin runway
- Repair crack between north end zone and inside edge of track
- Apply 2 coats of structural spray
- Layout and stripe running track

McConnell & Associates is providing the products, services, and construction administration services for the above referenced project through the TIPS/TAPS Purchasing Cooperative.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval of a contract with McConnell & Associates through the TIPS/TAPS Cooperative Purchasing Cooperative for the Free State High School track resurface and associated repairs at a cost of \$88,066.
