Re: Purchase of Projectors, Display Monitors & Installation Services – Deerfield

Date: June 9, 2016

Background:

Lawrence Public Schools will continue its bond construction projects this summer. Deerfield Elementary School is one of the schools included in these projects; therefore, the technology department has removed additional eight-year-old projectors. Over the last two years, the district has established a new standard for replacement projectors as classrooms have been remodeled.

Rationale:

All projectors and monitors have been purchased and installed through Kansas City Audio Visual for the buildings completing construction. Deerfield will be ready for new projectors and monitors prior to the start of school in the fall. KCAV has provided a quote for these projectors and display monitors.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends the purchase of projectors and display monitors from KCAV for Deerfield Elementary School for a total cost not to exceed \$47,920 to be paid from the Capital Outlay Instruction Technology budget under State of Kansas Contract #36416.

Motion:
