Re: Relocation of Playground Equipment – Pinckney

Date: June 22, 2017

Background:

As the 2013 Bond Construction project at Pinckney Elementary School nears completion, students will no longer attend at the East Heights building. Since the existing playground equipment located at East Heights will no longer be needed, it will be moved to Pinckney. District staff and Pinckney administration have given input to the relocation and placement of the equipment.

Bids and Specifications:

The scope of work includes the removal of existing playground equipment at East Heights and the installation at Pinckney Elementary. All playground pieces meet and/or exceed the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standards, which is the Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Playground Equipment for public use. Game Time c/o Cunningham Recreation has provided a playground relocation and installation price through the U.S. Communities purchasing agreement.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval of a contract procured through the U.S. Communities purchasing agreement with Game Time c/o Cunningham Recreation for the relocation and installation of playground equipment from East Heights to Pinckney Elementary in the amount of \$31,706.62 to be paid from Capital Outlay Budget Fund.
