Re: Purchase of Security Cameras – Liberty Memorial Central, Southwest

Date: June 9, 2016

Background:

Liberty Memorial Central and Southwest Middle Schools have not had a security camera update in over five years. The district has established the Axis P3224 Security Camera as the new standard solution.

Rationale:

The current security systems at Liberty Memorial Central and Southwest are past end of life and are no longer supported. The functionality no longer meets minimum district requirements and therefore needs to be upgraded. Alexander Open Systems (AOS) has provided a quote for 120 indoor security cameras and 40 outside security cameras. These numbers will allow the district to upgrade the systems at both schools.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends the purchase of Axis P3224 Security Cameras via the Cooperating School Districts of Greater Kansas City Contract NO. C062512 through the AOS quote # Q11689 for a cost not to exceed \$82,536.29 to be paid from Capital Outlay funds for Technology.

Motion:

"I move the Board of Education approve the purchase of the Axis Security Cameras from Alexander Open Systems for Liberty Memorial Central and Southwest Middle Schools at a cost not to exceed \$82,536.29."
