Re: Contract for Blackboard Learning Management System, Year Five

Date: June 22, 2017

Background:

On July 22, 2013, the Board of Education approved a five year license and related software fees with Blackboard, Inc. for a Learning Management System.

Rationale:

The district will begin year five of five of the contract in the fiscal year 2017-2018. Total cost for year five is as follows:

Blackboard K-12 Innovative Classroom	\$ 95,680
Authentica Data Sense License for Learning	<u>8,715</u>
Total	\$104,395

Recommendation:

Administration recommends payment on an existing purchase order from July 22, 2013 for the agreed-upon amount of \$95,680, year five multi-year agreement and an additional payment of \$8,715 for license renewal cost for the district's Authentica Data Sense License also with Blackboard Inc. The total payment will be \$104,395 for July 22, 2017 to July 21, 2018.

"I move the Board of Education renew the Authentica Data Sense License for \$8,715 and K-12 Innovative Classroom for \$95,680 at a total cost of \$104,395 to Blackboard, Inc., representing year five of a five year agreement through July 21, 2018."
