Re: Purchase of Combination Ovens – Prairie Park, Liberty Memorial Central

Date: June 22, 2017

Background:

The USD 497 Food Services Department uses a combination “combi” oven for one of its cooking methods. The combi oven is a combination of dry heat and steam, so it can bake, steam, cook and hold, and crisp with a combination of both dry heat and bursts of steam. Prairie Park Elementary School and Liberty Memorial Central Middle School do not have this standardized piece of equipment, and the food service capital outlay budget has funds to purchase two units.

Rationale:

Bids were solicited for the equipment, removal and disposal of the old equipment. Bids were also received for the hook up of the electrical, water supply and drain lines. The results are as follow:

The district has worked with both Sunflower Restaurant Supply and TempCon in the past and is pleased with the work that has been performed.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval for the purchase of two combination ovens from Sunflower Restaurant Supply in the amount of \$28,896 and contract with TempCon for removal of old equipment and installation of new equipment in the amount of \$3,450 from the Capital Outlay Equipment Fund.

Motion:
