Re: 3D Scanning with Gould Evans – Lawrence High

Background:

On May 2, 2017, voters approved an \$87 million school bond issue to construct additions and renovate, improve, repair, equip, and furnish existing secondary schools throughout the district. Given the scope and complexity of the construction project at Lawrence High School, Gould Evans has contracted with a company called TruePoint Laser Scanning to provide 3 dimensional laser scanning in the amount of \$30,500.

Scope of Work

3D laser scanning can accurately and efficiently capture 3 dimensional data regardless of size and surface features by creating clear and precise digital records of existing conditions. The scan produces millions of measurement points. The intricate detail of these points can get an exact measurement from any one point to any other point.

Recommendation:

The Facility Planning Committee recommends board approval to reimburse Gould Evans for contracted 3 dimensional laser scanning services for the 2017 Bond Project at Lawrence High School in the amount of \$30,500 to be paid from the 2017 Bond Project Fund.
