

IE Planning for Instruction

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1 Each principal shall plan for staffing, scheduling, and class size.

2 Staffing

3 Staffing allocations are made according to district guidelines. Principals
4 use these allocations to make staffing decisions in their buildings.

5 Scheduling for Instruction

6 Class schedules shall be developed to meet district instructional goals and
7 standards.

8 Class Size

9 Class size is defined as the number of students regularly assigned to a
10 specific certified teacher in a general education classroom.

11 Class size shall be determined by the following factors: instructional
12 needs, best-practice, class enrollment, student demographics, teacher
13 availability, budget, and facility limitations.

14 ~~Elementary Class Size Goals~~

15 ~~— The goals for elementary classes are that they are a single grade level and~~
16 ~~sizes will be no more than 17 and no fewer than 13 students in grades~~
17 ~~Kindergarten through third, and no more than 26 and no fewer than 18 in grades~~
18 ~~fourth and fifth. While this policy sets the elementary class size goals of this~~
19 ~~district, it is understood that actual class sizes may vary significantly from~~
20 ~~these goals due to the previously listed determining factors.~~

21 Pre-enrollment

22 The district shall develop and coordinate pre-enrollment activities.

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
