**Background:**

Following voter approval on May 2, 2017 of an \$87 million school bond to construct additions, renovate, improve, repair, equip, and furnish existing secondary schools, administration has transitioned from bond planning to implementation. Construction at the Lawrence College and Career is underway. A portion of the project involves the purchase of equipment for the Culinary Kitchen.

**Bids and Specifications:**

Bids for equipping the kitchen were solicited from multiple vendors. The bids included but were not limited to ovens, refrigerators, freezers, dishwasher, tables, etc. The specifications were aligned to meet the space, instructional and safety requirements of the Culinary Arts Program.
