Background:

Lawrence Public Schools had been accessing professional learning opportunities offered by Greenbush (also known as Southeast Kansas Education Service) for several years. To attend or access these professional development opportunities, district staff paid an increased price as non-members. In Spring of 2016 a request was made for a proposal that provides their standard services package of professional development sessions, with the full ability to customize the professional learning plan at any time to accommodate the needs of our district. The Board of Education approved the contract that year and each subsequent year.

Rationale:

This enclosure represents the 2018-2019 Greenbush contract for School Improvement Services Support (Professional Learning).

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board of Education approve the renewal with Greenbush (Southeast Kansas Education Service Center) for professional learning services in the amount of \$25,500.00 paid from General Funds - Teaching and Learning Professional Development budgets.
