Re: Disposal of School Property – obsolete football jerseys

Date: December 10, 2018

Background:

Over the years, Lawrence High School (LHS) has accumulated various football jerseys that students no longer use. Lawrence High staff would like to sell the jerseys as a way to raise money for the LHS football program.

Rationale:

Kansas Statute and Board Policy DFM requires that excess equipment, uniforms and supplies and materials purchased by the district, or its schools, must be disposed of at the discretion of the Board of Education.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends allowing the disposal of obsolete football jerseys uniforms as a fundraiser for the LHS football program. Inventory of items to be sold and estimated pricing are as follows:

Revenue from the sale of jerseys would be directed back to the football program.
