Re: Renewal of Odysseyware Licenses for 2018-2019
Purchase of 2018 Summer School Licenses

Date: May 29, 2018

Background:

The Lawrence Diploma Completion Program uses Odysseyware as its online curriculum, the high schools and Juvenile Detention Center use Odysseyware for credit recovery and summer school courses.

Rationale:

Odysseyware school year licenses must be renewed on an annual basis and are purchased through the South Central Kansas Education Service Center. Odysseyware summer school licenses are purchased directly from Odysseyware.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends board approval of the renewal of 90 Odysseyware licenses for the 2018-2019 school year from the South Central Kansas Education Service Center at a cost of \$54,000. To accommodate 2018 summer school needs at both high schools and the Juvenile Detention Center, administration recommends the purchase of 30 summer school licenses at a cost of \$3,000. The Diploma Completion Center will fund the purchase of both the school year licenses and summer school licenses.
