Careers in **Media** also include Audio-Video Communications Technology, Telecommunications or Printing Technology which require strong backgrounds in computer and electronic-based technology and a solid foundation in math and science. All pathways require the ability to communicate effectively in both oral and written form. In addition, the creative aspects of this cluster are rapidly merging with the technological, making it even more challenging.
