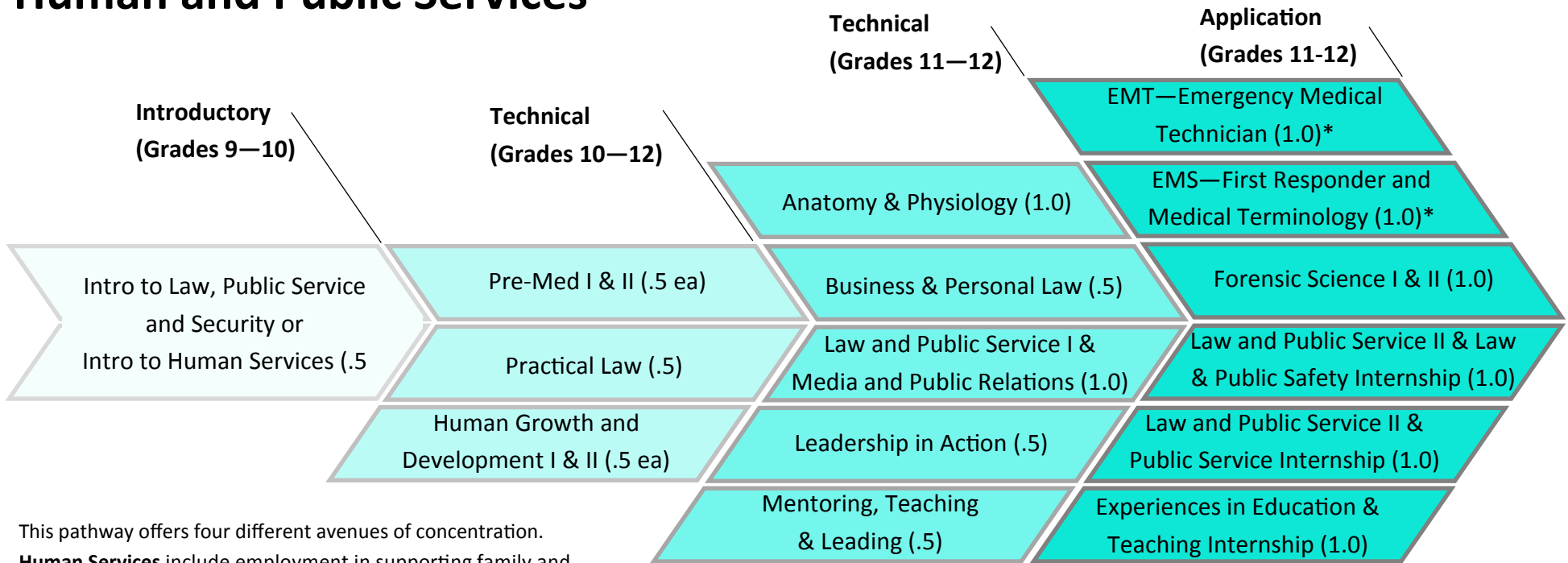

# Human and Public Services



This pathway offers four different avenues of concentration. **Human Services** include employment in supporting family and human needs. Careers in the **Education and Training** focus on planning, managing and providing education and training services, and related learning support services. **Government and Public Administration** includes jobs in federal, state and local services, including careers in **Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security** where employees are involved in legal, public safety, protective services and homeland security. Learners should have a good background in academic, technical and presentation/facilitation skills.



Students who complete the Law Public Safety and Security pathway (3 credits) with a minimum 3.0 high school GPA are eligible for 3 credits of CJ 100—Crime and Justice in America at Washburn University. Students who complete the Family and Community Services pathway (3 credits) with a minimum 3.0 high school GPA are eligible for 3 credits of HS 131—Human Development through Washburn University.



Students who complete Business & Personal Law, Law and Public Service I & II, and Public Service Internship can receive 6 college credits from Emporia State University.



\* Students may enroll in EMS-First Responder and Medical Terminology for 8 hours of college credit. The course is offered by JCCC at the College & Career Center. Students may also enroll in EMT—Emergency Medical Technician for 10 hours of college credit. This class is also offered by JCCC at the College & Career Center. Students should successfully complete EMS-First Responder and Medical Terminology before enrolling in EMT-Emergency Medical Technician.
