



The District Leadership Team met in late March. The team reviewed the feedback from building leadership teams on the 4 "R's". Through discussion and consensus, it was decided that the focus "R's" for this cycle of accreditation will be Relationships and Relevance.

Relevance focuses on Curriculum, Instruction, Student Engagement and our incorporation of Technology. Schools and the district will review the "current" view of what is going on in each of those areas with a focus of discovering areas of strength and areas of challenge.

Relationship focuses on inter-staff relationships, staff relationships with students, school and district relationships with families, and the schools' and district's relationship with the community. Again, schools and the district will review the current view of where we find ourselves in these areas with a focus of discovering areas of strength and areas of challenge.



The accreditation cycle is 5 years in length. We are currently in Year 1, and our Outside Visiting Team will be coming tomorrow (April 20), where we will share our current reality and listen to their feedback.
