



## PARENT INFORMATION about Immunization Requirements

The Kansas State Department of Health and Environment has issued regulations for immunizations required for the 2019-2020 school year. As per Kansas Statute 72-5209, all children upon entry to school must be appropriately vaccinated. If you need a copy of your child's current immunizations, you may access their records through PowerSchool Family Access on the [www.usd497.org](http://www.usd497.org) website or by contacting your school nurse.

Please note the following additions/changes in immunization requirements for the 2019-2020 school year:

- DTaP:** Five doses required. (No changes in requirements.)
- Tdap:** Booster dose of **Tdap** is required for students in grades 7-12 if no previous history of Tdap vaccination. If pertussis is contraindicated, a KCI Form B Medical Exemption should be completed by a physician.
- POLIO:** Four doses are required; three doses acceptable. (No changes in requirements.)
- MMR:** Two doses required. (No changes in requirements.)
- VARICELLA:** **TWO** doses required for students in grades K-12 **OR** documentation of varicella (chickenpox) disease by a **LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.**
- HEPATITIS B:** Three doses required for students in grades K-12.
- HEPATITIS A:** Two doses required for students in grades K-1.
- MENINGOCOCCAL:** One dose required for students in grades 7-11.
