

Kennedy Preschool

Enrollment begins April 3

The Pre-K program represents the dedication of the Lawrence Public Schools and the community to young children. The supporters of this program believe that early childhood education is an important experience that all children should enjoy prior to starting kindergarten.

This program serves children who live within the Lawrence Public Schools attendance area.
Children must be 4 years of age on or before August 31, 2017.

Families may qualify one of two ways:

Qualification Guideline #1

- Family is eligible for free lunch and
- Child is not attending another preschool program

OR

Qualification Guideline #2

- Family is eligible for reduced lunch and
 - Child is not attending another preschool program
- And also meets at least one of the following:**

- Custodial parent is unmarried
- Family is being referred by DCF**
- Was born to a teen parent
- Parent is lacking a high school diploma or GED
- Child qualifies for migrant status**
- English is the child's second language**

**Appropriate documentation must be on file to meet qualification requirements.

Cost:

- For those families who meet these qualifications, *there is no fee*

Hours:

- 4 full days per week – **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 8:00-3:05**
- No before or after school care available

Transportation:

- Parents must provide their child's transportation to and from the classroom.
