Chess Club, LHS

Constitution

ARTICLE I.

NAME: This organization shall be called the Chess Club, LHS.

ARTICLE II.

ELIGIBILITY for MEMBERSHIP: Any person attending Lawrence High may join. This includes students who attend for only one hour.

ARTICLE III.

GOALS: The goals of this organization are:

1. To give an opportunity to all to improve their higher thinking skills through learning and playing chess.
2. To promote friendship among students.
3. To give an opportunity to students to participate in interschool chess competition.

ARTICLE IV.

DUES: Dues for membership will be determined by each year's officers.

ARTICLE V.

CLUB FUNDS: The sponsor and/or treasurer will have the authority to approve the expenditure of club funds.

ARTICLE VI.

OFFICERS: Club officers will be elected each year. This will be determined by membership vote. The officers shall be:

A president, a Vice President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.

ARTICLE VII.

MEETINGS: The faculty sponsor will call the first meeting; after that, officers and members will hold meetings weekly or every other week, or as they shall determine.
