Aimee E. Ziegler Memorial Scholarship

Description: In memory of Aimee E. Ziegler, who was a counselor at LFSHS. She was well known in Lawrence for her involvement in creating the WRAP program and her numerous coaching positions at Free State. Average or above average GPA (minimum 2.5), but not for highest achievers. Must show solid effort toward academics and demonstrate financial need.

Preference given to students involved in school and/or community activities.
