

Caring for your iPad

- Your iPad comes with a district-issued case which is designed to protect the iPad. This is to remain on the device at all times.
- Feel free to sticker or draw on the case, but DO NOT decorate the device itself. All artwork must be school appropriate, must not damage the device and the district tag must be visible.
- Be prepared for class by charging your battery overnight! Charge your device in a commons space such as the living room or dining room in order to limit screen time. Leave your charger at home in a spot that you will remember!
- Fully charged iPads should last the entire school day. If you need to charge your iPad during the school day, lock it in one of the iPad charging lockers.
- Avoid accidents by keeping your iPad on a desk or table. Never leave your iPad on the floor, and never leave your iPad unattended.
- Damage to the screen occurs if too much pressure is applied. Avoid placing your iPad in the bottom of your backpack or purse to avoid accidental damage.
- Protect your device from extreme temperatures, moisture, as well as foods and liquid.
- Clean your iPad's screen with a soft cloth. Avoid using window cleaners or other liquids to clean the screen. This may damage the protective film and/or the device if moisture gets into the iPad.
