Consider questions to ask providers: www.cddo.cwood.org/questions ● Ensure applications for services are submitted to chosen agencies (some agencies may have internal waiting lists) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Establish timeline for transition from school to adult services. ● I/DD Waiver Service Types including Day, Residential, In-Home Supports and others: www.cddo.cwood.org/services ● Employment Resources: www.cddo.cwood.org/employment
