Reviewed Staff "Mustang Minute" Communication:

Review the Safe Return to LMCMS slide show that was presented to students.

- Students will still have temperature checks
- students will have restroom breaks during classes.
- Lunch will be 3 lunches by grade level but between cafeteria and gym
- Dismissal will be at 3:05 for all students

The goal is to have 20-25 students in classes

-Question about if lockers would be considered. It is current practice to have students move briskly from classroom to classroom.

-The schedule for the remainder of 2020-21 school year was shared.

Question on the process of switching students from remote to in-person. It is being handled on a case by case basis.

Question if the block schedule will be the rest of the year. Yes it will. Mondays and Thursdays will be odd hour classes, Tuesdays and Fridays even hour classes and Wednesdays will rotate odd even.

Question if parents have the option of changing students status remote to hybrid or vice versa. Deadline for parents to change was Friday February 26. School will accommodate if possible. Hybrid teachers will not turn their webex on. Essential teacher will be teaching both.

Summer School

- It looks like it will be a 3 week program that will be half days.
- Each school will recruit 100 students
- LMCMS and West
- Safety protocols will still be followed
- busing will be provided
