

Lawrence Community Food Resources

Salvation Army food pantry hours are Monday – Friday, 9 – 12. This is available once per month for each registered individual. Call 785-843-4188 to find out the next time the pantry is open. You will need to provide:

- Picture ID for ages 18+ for applicant
- Proof of income such as a recent pay stub
- Proof of address such as a utility bill or lease agreement
- Social Security Cards for each member of the home. If you do not have them, you can apply for one at the social security office. They will provide a letter confirming the application for the card and this letter will also be accepted at the Salvation Army. If you do not have the cards, you can provide an official document with the numbers included such as an income tax return.

Penn House Food Pantry (842-0440) is available once a month per registered family. The hours are Monday – Thursday, 8 – 11 & 1 – 3. Friday is 8 – 11 only. You will need to provide:

- Picture ID for ages 18+ for applicant
- Proof of income such as a recent pay stub
- Proof of address such as a utility bill or lease agreement
- Social Security Cards for each member of the home. They *will not* accept a letter confirming a social security card application from the social security office. Once an application has been made it takes about 2 weeks to receive the cards. If you do not have the cards, you can provide an official document with the SS numbers included such as an income tax return. *They must have legal proof of the SS numbers.*

Ballard Center Food Pantry – (842-0729) – Once registered the food pantry is available once a month per family on Monday – Friday from 9 – 5. Call to find out the next time the pantry is open. You will need to provide:

- Picture ID for ages 18+ for applicant
- Proof of income such as a recent pay stub
- Proof of address such as a utility bill or lease agreement
- Social security cards for each member of the home. If you do not have the cards, you can provide an official document with the numbers included such as an income tax return. *They must have legal proof of the numbers.*

Trinity Interfaith Food Pantry – 1011 Vermont Street – (843-6166) – Food Pantry hours of operation are Tuesdays 2:30 – 4:30 and Saturdays 10 – 12 every week. No identification or proof of income is required.

Social Security Office – 1440 Wakarusa Dr. – 843-2254 – toll free 1-800-772-1213.

ECKAN “Just Food” Pantry at 1200 E. 11th (856-7030) – is available once a month per family. Hours of operation are M – F 9-noon & 1-4. You will need to complete a registration form, provide photo ID for ages applicants 18+, and *social security numbers for each member of your family*. Applicant will need to sign a self-declaration that income is at or below 200% of poverty level (which will change to 124% on October 1st, 2010.) At the intersection of 11th and Haskell, look for “Just Food” sign pointing to a grey warehouse.

L.I.N.K. – Lawrence Interdenominational Nutritional Kitchen – the entrance is located in the basement of the red brick First Christian Church on 10th street between Vermont and Kentucky streets. They provide lunch on a regular basis from 1-2 on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday.

Leo Center – 841-7297, One River Front Plaza, Suite 100 is available once per month per family. Hours are Saturdays, 10 – 12. Only criteria are to sign one’s name and number of people being fed in family.

First Baptist Church – 843-0020, 1330 Kasold Dr. is available 3 times per week per family. Hours are Mondays and Fridays, 2- 4 pm and Wednesday s 10:00 am- noon. Only criteria are to sign one’s name and number of people being fed in family.

Southside Church of Christ – 843-0770, 1105 W. 25th St. is available once per 6 weeks per family. Hours are Monday through Thursday, 9:30 – 1:30. Please call before you go.

Jubilee Café – 841-7500, First United Methodist Church, 946 Vermont St. Breakfast is served Tuesdays and Fridays from 7am – 8am. All are welcome.
